Some have been charged, but I have no doubt legal evidence of that fact. Of this sort is the account against Major Long, except the part which the Major states belongs to his son, that against Sept. Foster & his W. H. Heyden, & J. R. Clark were for money and articles which they went to have as apprentices & servants, & I have no doubt the account was liquidated when they left the ship. The account against J. R. Clark was settled when Foster bought the Break Point of Providence, but another rect. is still open, I thought it proper to return it.
