

## Deverly Cary Deceased

We Harold P. Stanley and Joel Cusley two of the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Cumberland, pursuant to an act of the general assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, approved the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1834 authorizing and directing the appointment of Commissioners for the purpose of settling with administrators, &c. &c. Proceeded to State an account Current and settle with Leander Cary administrator of the estate of Deverly Cary deceased, as follows
