First I ordain that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate. Second It is my desire that my beloved wife Sarah Scott shall have and hold for her use and benefit and Comfort (for herself) during her natural life, all of my Estate, both real, and personal Consisting of Lands, heres and Cattle, Sheep, hogs, plantation tools, House &

Kitchen furniture &c. &c. Third. It is also my will & desire that if my beloved wife Sarah Scott shall think proper to give off any part of my said Estate to my children before her natural death, Allen Scott, Archable Scott, Nancy Anderson, Fanny Skipper, Martin Scott, Mary Scott, Lucy Mathews, Willy Skipper, It is my will she shall do so provided she gives them all an Equal part. Fourth. It is my will & desire that after the death of my beloved wife Sarah Scott that the remainder or balance of my said Estate to be Equally divided amongst my afore mentioned children. Fifth. I do appoint my Son Allen Scott & my Son-in-law Ashford Skipper Executors of my Estate. The within will and Testament is hereby acknowledged by me to be my last Will and Testament this 21<sup>st</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord 1840.
