1st I desire that all my perishable property be immediately sold after my death and out of the money arising there from all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid & should the perishable part of my estate prove insufficient for the above purposes then I desire that my Executor hereafter named shall dispose of part or all of my tract of Land that I now live on and the remainder of the money after paying the just debts or the balance if not sold and I desire that it should not be sold if there are enough property to pay the debts with out it, I leave to my beloved wife ^{Sally} Warinner all the Land during her natural life and at her death the Land to be sold and the money arising there from to be proportioned equally amongst all my children first making those that have received their proportion with those that have I mean the advance I have made to my children that has married I further give to my son in law Daniel C. Cab Biba two acres of land to be laid off to him around the house he now lives in ^{in proportion to his power provided he builds my wife} and he has now on hand or as long as he will stay & occupy it himself all the rest of my estate both real & personal of whatsoever kind it may be not herein before particularly disposed of I desire may be equally divided amongst my several children To wit L.
