And lastly I nominate and appoint my wife Eunice Hillis and William R Hillis my Joint Executors of this my last will and Testament And do healy revoke and make null all and void all wills by me made or said to be by me made I only declare this to be my last will and Testament and no other in testimony whereof I have hereunto set to my hand and affixed my seal this ^{the} day and date above written
