The following are the statements which were made by William A Malthall at his own habitation in his last sickness when he was in his proper mind on the 19th of Sept 1834. He called upon me (So) (Take) notice that he was about to die & it was his desire after his Just debts were paid he wished his wife Kearley (So) have all of his estate of every description that should be left her it Settled or unSettled (So) dispose of at her own discretion stating that it she thought proper either (So) Give or loan (So) any of her children any of the property she might do so at her own pleasure. (He) said something about writing a will but in the mean while stated that it was but short & that those who were present would recollect it and At the same time he called upon John Anderson partner & said uncle John this is my desire I am in my right mind It is what I am always intended

We whose names are hereunto subscribed were both present when the above statements were made Given under our hands this 27th of Oct 1834
