

Levi Haggards Will

In the name of God, Amen, I Levi Haggard of the County of Cumberland and State of Kentucky, being infirm and weak in body but of sound mind & disposing memory, do make this as my last will and Testament, annulling and revoking all other wills by me heretofore made -

First It is my will and desire, that after my death, all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid -
Secondly - I give to my nephew David Swift all my right and title to the tract of land, upon which he now lives, lying and being in the County of Cumberland, it being a tract of land which I purchased at a Sheriffs sale, by virtue of an execution against him - I also give to him the benefit of a mortgage which he executed to me, to secure the payment of three hundred dollars.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my sister Anne all the balance of my estate of every description, during her natural life, and after her death, I give & bequeath the same to my three nieces viz - Martha, Sally & Lucy Haggard to have and to hold forever.

Fourthly. It is my will and desire, that my Executor hereafter named, shall have the possession of all my estate hereby willed to my sister Anne, and that he shall manage and Control the same for the use and benefit, as he may think expedient.

Fifthly I do hereby constitute & appoint my friend David Mallock Executor of this my last will & Testament.
