

In Obedience to the order of the County Cumberland County Court  
of their May Term 1829 We John J. J. J. Williams  
Wood James Cowan and Thomas Wood being first sworn  
have proceeded to lay off divide and allot the lands of which  
Jacob Sandusky had seized and possessed between the  
Heirs of the said Decedent state which from report to us we  
find to be severe and we are informed that Samuel  
Campbell who resides on said lands has purchased five of  
the aforesaid shares

which we have omitted to specially  
designate they belonging <sup>us</sup> to one man and we also are informed  
that the Children of John Duval and his wife Elizabeth to  
whom now deceased are Heirs of the aforesaid Estate as to one share  
and of them are Infants and Minors we therefore have  
proceeded to lay off and allot to them one share of said  
Sandusky <sup>land</sup> ~~land~~ which is represented to us to be  
213 acres one third part of which is allotted to the late widow  
Sandusky now Mrs. Polly Graves as her dower and we have  
proceeded to lay off and allot to the said Heirs of Jacob Sandusky  
deceased being Children of John Duval and his late wife  
Elizabeth Twenty acres in the S E. Corner of said land in  
Cumberland County on the Spring Branch Beginning at a  
Poplar and Dogwood the old Corner thence with old line S  
47 E 57 poles to a stake 41 feet S 6 <sup>from</sup> marked Black  
Oak thence S 43 W 56 and one half poles  
a stake thence N 43 W 57 poles to a stake on the old line thence  
N 43 E 56 and one half poles to the Beginning we also allotted and  
laid off to the Heirs of the aforesaid John Duval Ten acres of land  
in the S W Corner of the aforesaid Tract and within the lower  
part Beginning at a Sugar tree Buckeye and Lyrer the  
old Corner thence with the old line North 43 E 40 poles  
to a stake near a poplar stump thence N 32 W 113 and  
three fourths poles to a rock at the foot of Hill thence S 43  
W 32 poles to a stake on the old line thence S 32 E 44  
poles to a stake James Cowan thence S 71 W 7 poles to a stake  
thence S 29 E 11 poles to the Beginning where we dem-  
onstrated a stake to said Heirs as could be reasonably allotted to them  
& Samuel Campbell the owner of the other shares was present  
& assented to the app. allotment given under our hands  
as Commissioners on the premises this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1829  
expence incurred 1 dollar per-day Each for one days attendance as  
Commissioners and for Survey the two above named lots of Coun-  
sel
