Orsley, Commissioners appointed by the Cumberland County Court to settle with Executors Administrators & Guardians, do hereby Certify that upon a settlement with Levi Haggard executor of Rice Haggard deceased, do find said estate of Rice Haggard indebted to said Executor Levi Haggard, the sum of forty five Dollars and thirty three Cents.

James Haggard, James Saufley and David R. Haggard, heirs of Rice Haggard deceased, except to the within report for the following reasons viz. First. Because the Credits allowed to Levi Haggard as executor, are allowed, entirely without proof.

Secondly. Because vouchers for which the greater portion of said allowance, was made, have not been filed as the law requires.

Thirdly. Because no services were rendered by said executor in relation to the within named estate & no expenses incurred in relation thereto, save the fee bill of 83 cents mentioned within.

Haggard the heirs of said Rice Haggard deceased, filed their exceptions to said Settlement, the Court upon hearing the case & on examination & Consideration, It is the Opinion of the Court, and they so order that the said report be rejected, except the first Credit N: 1 and the 3^d Credit for allowance to Commissioners and the said Court report and their order, is ordered to be recorded by the Clerk of this Court." —
