 Second. I Will & bequeath 1/3rd of my estate to my beloved wife both real
 & personal during her natural life, & at her death to be equally divided among
 my children or their lawful heirs. Third. My Will is that my daugh-
 ters shall be made equal in property out of my personal estate with
 my Daughters Mary Anne as they become of age. Fourth. My Will is
 that the remaining part of estate shall be kept together until my young-
 est child becomes of age at which time and equal division to be made by
 my executors between my several children to wit. Mary A. Allen, Eliza-
