 that is to say after the payment just debts and funeral
 Expenses of Give to my wife Hannah Lang all that part
 of my land with the houses orchards and all the appurtenances
 thereon and thereunto belonging which lies above the lower
 brass fence of my lower field that fence supposed to run
 nearly north & south the course of that fence to be the
 corner the line is to be run below across my Survey
 and all the Land above to be hers during her natural
 life & at her decease to be sold and the money to be

equally divided amongst all my heirs herein after mentioned
 all my personal estate to be sold as soon in the face here
 next ensuing after my decease as my exec may think it
 will bring the best price and my wife to have her share
 part of the proceeds of said sale, all the part of land
 lying West of the black field fence above specified and
 the line that is to be run - as above named knowing as the
 lower end of my lands to be rented or leased, as my exec may
 think best and the proceeds arising therefrom to be appropri-
 ated as much as may be necessary to the schooling of my two
 youngest sons to wit William & Edward Lang to be taught
 reading and writing & arithmetic, I give to my son Wiley
 Lang one hundred dollars to my son Samuel Lang one
 hundred dollars to my son Joel Lang one hundred dollars
 to be paid out of the sales and of my first property and
 when my youngest son Edward Lang arrives to the age of
 twenty one years then the lower part of my land as above
 & last mentioned to be sold, and my Negro boy named Isaac
 and out of the proceeds of that sale to my two youngest sons
 William & Edward to have two hundred dollars apiece and
 the balance of the proceeds of my said sale to be equally
 divided amongst all my children herein after mentioned to wit
 Wiley Lang Samuel Lang Joel Lang Elizabeth Blair wife of Joel
 Blair Polly Denton wife of Joseph Denton, William Lang and
 Edward Lang but to be strictly understood that my two daughter
 above named not to have any part of my estate until
