I Thomas Barton Esq of Lumberland County & State of
 Kentucky do hereby make my last will and
 testament in manner & form following that is to say
 I do hereby declare that my last will and testament
 of the Præces of my estate & I give to my
 son Thomas Barton & his heirs forever and to my
 heirs and servants & one benevolent lady to each
 of them & I give to my wife Sarah Barton & her
 heirs & servants & one negro man named
 Philip for her benefit during her life and after
 death to dispose of the same in any manner
 that she may think proper I also give to my wife
 all my lands lying in Lumberland County together
 with all my stock of every kind household

I Fithen furniture the same being for her own proper use & benefit during her natural life but not to have it in her power to sell or convey the lands or any part thereof without the advice & consent of my Executors herein after mentioned. It is also my further will & desire that if there should be an opportunity of selling my lands or if my wife & my Executors should conceive it would be for the advancement of the estate at any time to sell my lands they are hereby authorized do and make & ratify such conveyances as to them seem proper & shal be a sale as bona mentioned ever be effected during my wife's life the proceeds thereof to be equally divided among all my children except Grace, Anne, & William & Bartol Thomas & Bartol Leonard & Bartol the surviving heirs of my Daughter Lucy. My wife, Susannah Barton & Caroline Barton but they reserving to my wife the same interest & benefit for her support & maintenance as hitherto mentioned & it should a sale of lands before mentioned be effected during the life of my wife, it is my desire it shal be divided at her death in manner & form following I Give Anna Mary - & to the heirs of my Daughter Lucy. My wife, Susannah, Sarah Salter, Arthur Harris, Mary, Henry, Thomas, Lewis, Henry - a half Calvert, Henry, Lucy, Harriet, Mary, one certain tract or parcel of land which the said Anna Mary now lives & is married to the lands of William Parker John List William Howard & George Allen also a dividing line as designated by me between the said Anna Mary & my son William & Bartol reserving at the same time the value of one fourth part of said lands for the benefit of my daughter Susannah Barton which the said Anna Mary is bound to make good to her & I Give to my son William & Bartol one tract or parcel of land adjoining the above on the north side thereof & being the tract of land whereon I now live & is married by the name of Anna Mary - George Allen Thomas & Bartol as designated by me heretofore making a reserve to my daughter Susannah of the one fourth part as before mentioned & I Give to my son Thomas & Bartol one certain tract or parcel of land bounded as follows to wit by a new line between him & my son William & Bartol the line of George Allen William & Bartol & Caroline Barton also a share of the value of the one fourth to Susannah as before mentioned & I Give to my son William & Bartol one certain tract or parcel of land bounded by the lines of Thomas & Bartol George Allen & George Harris proposed line between him & Caroline Barton.

but reserving a Sonnes share of land lying between
 the houses of Langston Place & George Allen being
 the place wherean George Thomson bore line, to
 be otherwise disposed of should my Executors
 think proper so to do and at the same
 making a reserve of the value of one 1/4 part for
 the benefit of my Daughter Susanna Barton &c
 I give to my daughter Caroline Barton and
 her heirs &c forever of land Bourne as
 follows bounded by the lines of Langston Place West
 Barton & Thomas Barton Thos. S & P West
 thereby by a new line as signated by me it being
 the place wherean Matt Pole now lives reserving
 the value of the one 1/4 part of said land to my
 Daughter Susanna Barton & I give to Matt
 Pole & his heirs &c forever of the houses & other
 buildings & other parts of land lying
 in Waverley being the houses of Charles &c
 containing by estimation 169 acres reserving the
 value of the one 1/4 part to the benefit
 of my daughter Susanna Barton it is to be
 expressly expressed that whenever the before men-
 tioned legacies or any one or more of them shall
 pay or have to be paid to my daughter Susanna
 Barton the sum of 1000 each she is then to receive
 them from any further claims or demands as
 before mentioned & the title to their lands to be
 completely vested in them for the further &c
 better understanding the gifts here made to
 my wife in my lands that I house & other furniture
 is to belong to her maintenance which is to be under
 the direction of my 2 sons heretofore mentioned as
 my Executors 10th It is my will & desire that as to the
 residue and profits of my estate there be
 any thing more than will be an ample support
 to my wife & family I shall be for the benefit
 of my 2 sons Thomas & Malcolm &c & at the
 death of my wife it is my desire that all my personal
 estate of every description not heretofore given
 in this will shall be equally divided between
 my 2 sons Thomas & Barton & William Barton should
 my daughter Susanna die possessed of any
 of any part of the legacies left her in this will
 I desire it be equally divided between my legacies
 my surviving & children I give to my 2 sons
 & little Barton so long as they may live & be
 to each other but in case of a separation I give
 them to my son Thomas & one & lastly I do hereby
 appoint & constitute my sons Thomas & Malcolm
 & others of this my last will & testament hereby
 appointing each other & former executors by me made
