I then I bequeath that the whole of my of my estate both real & personal be subject to the payment of my just debts and the which may remain if any - both real and personal I gave to my dear beloved wife Elizabeth Slater to be for her use and at her disposal forever having my wife Elizabeth Slater my whole and sole executor given under my hand and seal the 15 day of October 1847.

 Item 4<sup>th</sup> I will bequeath unto my grand daughter Nancy Rowe my negro woman whose name Hillab together with her increase. Item 5<sup>th</sup> I will & direct that all my property - both real and personal not all ready advised & disposed of be sold & that the proceeds of the same to given with what money I may have on hand or that may be due
