that my Eight children shall have their ear and share
alike equally, William, Thomas, Jerry, Lucy, Lydia,
Ann, Mary, Penelope; I appoint my wife and my
son ~~William~~ Jerry and William Wagoner my Executors
I therefore read this instrument and sensible of settling my
affairs this 16th of March 1817 in the presence of those
