

My will and desire is that the property left to Margerita Ann Lee be to her bodily heirs and that if she should die without issue that the property be equally divided between her brothers & sisters I will to Mary Elizabeth Lee one negro boy by the name of Lewis to her bodily heirs forever, and if she should die without issue to be equally divided between her brothers & sisters the boy named is one of Matilda's children & being her part of the first increase as before named of Matilda's

further I leave the balance of Matilda's children of any I wish to be equally divided between the children of Abner Lee

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In the name of God Amen, The twenty 4th of January one thousand eight hundred & thirty six

I Benjamin Newton of the County of Davies and State of Kentucky being soundly affected in body with decline but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will, will & testament at the same time utterly revoking all former wills made by me declaring this to be my last will and testament

First I give and bequeath to my daughter Priscilla McCormick one negro boy Allen to her and her heirs forever at the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars with some other farms I have done for her that I cannot expect to do for the rest of my children

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Kelly one negro boy Isaac which has been previously deeded to her by deed of gift

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary one negro girl & boy Mariah & William at five hundred and fifty dollars to her & her heirs forever

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my daughter Demurrah one negro boy Washington at five hundred and fifty dollars to her & her heirs forever

Fifthly It is my will and desire that my grand daughter Helen K Newton should have an equal share of my estate with my children and that my executor shall have her part of my estate allotted and assigned to her when ever he may think it advisable and to the advantage of said Helen, And the estate

Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Anna the following negroes viz Braxton Shibe Moses Armistead and Sarah Ann and I further give my wife five head of horses viz Jane Pegg Flopety and three Cobs and two hundred acres of land to include the house and farm together with the Crop of Corn oats

Hay and fodder and all the stock of Hogs and as many of the Cattle as she may think sufficient but it is my will and desire that my wife shall give Mary and Fomimah each a bed and bedding and such other things as I have given my other daughters that have left me whenever they may need and also my grand daughter Helen K Newton one Bed & Bedding as my daughter are to have during her natural life

Seventhly I give and bequeath to my daughter Dianci Jane one negro girl Catharine at three hundred dollars to her and her heirs forever

Eighthly It is my will and desire that my executor shall sell my boy Troy for the best price he can get for the purpose of raising money to pay my debts and it is my

desire that my negro woman Liddy be set up and sold to the highest bidder if she will bring anything and if she will not then set her up for the lowest bidder and her expenses be paid out of my estate

Tenthly It is further my will and desire that the balance of my negroes viz John Thomas Leachariah and Larkin be kept on the place to keep to support the family unless it should be thought advisable to hire John or Thomas or both of them out which either one or both must be hired if they do not behave well stay at home and attend to business well as long as the executor may think it to the interest of a majority of the heirs and when the hire amounts to four hundred dollars over and above what is necessary for the support of the family I wish it equally divided amongst all my heirs

Eleventhly It is my will and desire that my land subject to the use of my heirs except the five acres which I have left to my wife until her death and then to be equally divided among my heirs

Twelfthly It is my will and desire that my grand daughter Helen K Newton & shall be sent to school and given a good common english education and the expense be paid out of my estate

Thirteenthly it is my will and desire that all of my estate both real and personal & ~~moveable~~ shall be equally divided amongst all my children & grand daughters Helen K Newton and viz Dianna Graves Priscilla McCormick Elizabeth Kelly Mary Newton & Jeremiah McCormick after deducting three hundred dollars from the part of Dianna Graves

Fourteenthly it is further my will and desire that the part that hereafter may come to my daughter Elizabeth shall be subject to the control of my executor in the same manner that is expressed in the deed of gift for Isaac and as Isaac is worth 24 hundred dollars the other are all to have fifty dollars more than the Elizabeth is at the next division

Fifteenthly, It is my will and desire that Sally Newton the widow of Charles K Newton deceased should be supported as she has been since she has been in my family

Sixthly I support my brother Williams and James Newton my Executors of this my last will and testament to which I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty six
