be had for the same and should he decess his administration
and that Eliza Johnson receive one hundred dollars
of said money for the benefit of her and her heirs & that
Harriet Albate her receive one hundred dollars for this
benefit and that Ellen Jones receive one hundred and
sixty dollars for her benefit and heirs and that James
Winans her receive the balance of the money as they
are of age paid for said tract and that Susa Barnhill
attend to the same & I will that the balance of my
property belong to my Rachel during her life or widowhood
and that at her death or marriage it to be divided
equally between my children to wit Rufus J Britton
Hannah Ann Britton Jasper Britton Jr. Anne Britton
Saml Britton Wm P Britton Rachel Britton Ariam
Britton and untoward him if any and that said
Barnhill make Wm Miles agent and warrant deed
to twenty six and one half acres of land which is surveyed
Jasper Britton
Joining him pending my property and heirs when the
