~~sd~~ will annexed) of the Estate of ~~sd~~ Robert Allin dec^d are
granted them in due form of Law, who thereupon gave
bond in the penalty of \$1000 and proof was moreover made
that the Testator at the time of his decease resided in Danvers
County - In testimony whereof that the same is duly recorded
I hereunto set my hand, this 2^d day of February 1818.
