 the worshipful Court of said County at their last term appointing us
 Commissioners to rectify mistakes in the division formerly made
 of the lands of Thomas Scott dec'd among the legatees of said Scott dec'd
 we having caused the said lands to be again surveyed by John Whinary
 & W. Allen Privat, who together with the chain carriers being duly sworn
 will & truly to measure said lands they have reported us that instead
 of 700 acres said to be the quantity when formerly divided there is
 759 1/2 acres making a surplus of 10 1/2 acres which we caused to be
 divided into eight equal parts making to each legatee a surplus
 of 2.1.30. which when added to their former shares, as drawn by
 lot; and also when some mistakes in some of the lines of Lot No.
 6th were rectified, the result was as follows: to-wit:

Lot No. 1st formerly drawn by Thomas Scott representative of
 George McKim & Nancy his wife late Nancy Scott & her legatees
 viz to said Thomas Scott, containing with his parts of the surplus
 82.1.30. & bounded as follows Beginning at A two hickories one on
 each side of David's fork near the mouth of a small branch,
 running thence up said branch N. 40 E. 106 ft to C, a barberry log
 & hickory, thence N. 33 3/4 E. 111 ft to D, a white oak & two ash trees
 thence N. 54 1/2 W. 89 ft to E, a barberry & hickory thence S. 68 W.
 99 ft to F, two hickories on a hill top thence thence to G
 25 1/2 E. 107 ft to H, two hickories & being down a white oak
 on the bank of said fork thence up the middle of the same with its meadow
