Chosen & I give and bequeath to My Daughter Catharine Brown all the use profits and possession of the plantation whereon she now lives, and which I purchased of Stephens Collins And by him deeded to me for and during her natural life And I hereby invest my Executors with full power and Authority to secure to My said Daughter Catharine the full Possession and full and unrestricted enjoyment of all and singular the rents profits and immunities of whatever kind of in the said Plantation And I farther Vest in the hands of My Executors five hundred Dollars Out of My personal Estate which I will and Ordain that they let Out for the best interest they can so as to secure and pay said interest as they shall receive it to My said Daughter Catharine And at her death Or so soon thereafter as her youngest Child shall arrive of the age of twelve years I will And Ordain that My Executors sell by private Or public Sale My said Plantation hereby empowering them Or the Survivor of them if by deed And that the proceeds of said sale be added to the said five hundred Dollars And together with the interest if there should be My And divide the whole Amount Share And Share alike to each of the Children born of the body of My said Daughter Catharine And pay it to them as they shall severally arrive at the age of twenty One years together with any interest the May have received thereon but should My said Daughter Catharine Die before her husband James Brown And before her youngest Child is ~~of~~ ^{over} twelve years of age I will And Ordain that the said James Brown have the use of the said Plantation Under the special direction of My Executors for the Maintenance of the Children of My said Daughter Catharine until
