Denton and my son Walter Bullock the Executors to this my last Will and Testament Revolving and discharging all other which may have been heretofore made And it is my Will and Desire that my Executors shall not be required to give Security for the performance of their Trust and that my Estate shall not be appraised but only inventoried in the usual form In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal on the day and year above Written James Bullock Seal
