 in body but right in mind and sound in Judgement  
 blessed be almighty god for the same do make and publish  
 this my last will and testament in manner and form follow-  
 ing that is to say First I give unto my beloved wife Ann  
 Neal the track of land or plantation I now live on during  
 her life together with all my estate both real and personal  
 but subject to the following legacies first I leave and bequeath  
 unto my eldest daughter Catharine Colbert a negro girl named  
 by name together with other personal property to the  
 amount of thirty six pounds which she is also to have possession  
 of I also give and bequeath unto my second daughter Betty  
 a negro girl named by name together with other personal  
 property to the amount of thirty six pounds I also leave and  
 bequeath to my third daughter Gracy a negro girl named  
 Anna together with other personal property to the amount  
 of thirty six pounds I also will and bequeath unto my  
 daughter Jane a negro girl named Maria together with  
 other personal property to the amount of thirty six pounds  
 I also will and bequeath unto my daughter Ann a negro  
 girl named Malinda together with other personal property  
 to the amount of thirty six pounds I also leave and bequeath  
 unto my daughter Frances a negro boy named Nelson together  
 with other personal property to the amount of thirty six pounds  
 I also leave and bequeath unto my son Charles a negro  
 boy named Jacob together with other personal property to the  
 amount of thirty six pounds also seventy acres of land on the  
 lower part the track Beginning at a hackberry and sugar  
 tree and come at Right hand running in a straight line

to include the above mentioned number of acres And I desire  
 that any of the negroes should die that is bequeathed is above  
 mentioned to any of the legates before the come of age at which  
 time they are to possess their legacies my will and desire is also  
 that he or she shall have another in lieu thereof namely the  
 eldest living negro child born in the estate after the underwritten  
 date I do also publish will and desire that they part of the estate  
 that is mentioned to my beloved wife Ann Neal whom I appoint  
 as my lawfull executrix is to be in her possession during her  
 natural life and at her decease to be equally divided amongst  
 any surviving children I do also appoint William Stone John  
 Stone and Peyton Colbert executor of this my last will and  
 Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made In witness  
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of  
 March in the year of our lord 1809

 by the above named Charles Neal to  
 be his last will and Testament in the
