

To David Smith (who is entitled by the will of his share) we have allotted N^o 2 and 7 the first containing in front on high street seven poles and thirteen poles back the latter containing on said street six & 1/2 poles in front and fifty one poles back. To Hannah Smith N^o 8 containing seven poles in front on same street and fifty one poles back. To John Smith another row number 4 and 5 fronting the late continuation of Lexington street the first six poles the second twelve poles in front and twenty poles back.

To Levi J Smith another row number 1 lying at the corner of High and Lexington streets in front six poles and thirteen poles back, and number 6 fronting Lexington Street sixteen poles and twenty poles back.

Seen under our hands and seals the 17th day of July 1809.

In the name of God amen I Christanna Price of Fayette County State of Kentucky do hereby make this my last will in manner and form following to wit that is to say my will and desire is that my dear Sarah Bryan is to have one feather bed and furniture one shaper and my flax wheel and the residue of my Estate and that which is coming to me of my Father's Estate both real and personal I give to my son James Price and his heirs forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of May 1809.

In the name of God amen I Thomas Lewis of Fayette County and State of Kentucky calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die and being desirous to settle and dispose of that estate that it has pleased God to bestow on me and is as follows to wit I give unto my son Hector ten shares in the Kentucky Insurance Company he having a sufficient portion of my estate already given him. I give unto my son Mr five hundred acres of Land whereon he now lives and to be laid off at that end of the tract and join the old line and to be laid at right angle to include the quantity, the balance of the tract I give unto my four sons Stephen Thornton Alpheus and Douglas to be equally divided among them as to quantity and quality. I give unto my Children Nancy Garrard a son Lewis Sally Blay Kitty Payne Stephen Lewis Thornton Lewis Sophia Lewis Alpheus Lewis and Douglas Lewis each of them ten shares in the Kentucky Insurance Company. I hereby confirm the gift of all my property heretofore given to my son in law Mr Septimus Dudley. I give unto my grand son Edward Anderson Dudley one thousand dollars which is now
