 aforementioned and the balance of money arising from said estate to be divided equally
 among the three whole of my children Sarah Rollings Martha Brown Mary Lamb
 Elizabeth Foster niece Nuttle Thomas Nuttle Rebecca Nuttle Susannah Nuttle
 and Nancy Nuttle to them and their heirs forever and should my son John
 Nuttle or Thomas Nuttle die and leave no heir the remaining one is to have the
 other land the other estate equally divided as is before mentioned. I also deem that
