Surveyed for Susannah A. de' widow of Randall A. de' dec' Fifty acres of land lying & being in the County of Fayette on the water of Boone creek, Beginning at a sugar tree and Hickory corner to Hannah in Sub line, thence South 1/2 East sixty one and half poles to manure corner a Hickory, thence South 1/2 West with money line one hundred eleven & one tenth pole to a stake, thence North 1/2 West eighty & one fourth pole to a stake, thence East one hundred eleven poles one tenth to the beginning

In the name of God amen, I George Pruit being of sound mind but weak in body and under apprehensions of my approaching dissolution, do make ordain and constitute this my last will & testament, first I give and bequeath unto my wife Temperance my negro woman Phillis also my negro girl Betty, also my negro girl baby also my negro girl Ben with the increase of the above mentioned negro, also I name my negro boy also I name my negro boy also my negro boy John which are to be for the benefit of my beloved wife during her life and at her death to be divided among my children agreeable to the legacies hereafter to be mentioned, I also give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Betty my negro girl Margaretta Matilda and Essi, I give and bequeath to my son Warren my negro girl Solley and also my negro boy Handy I name my daughter Pamela my negro girl Betty Filled and my negro boy William and Washington, I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly I name my negro boy John, I give and bequeath to my son Wadell my negro girl Lady & Jesse I also bequeath to my son Warren the whole of my Mitatory land, It is also my will and desire that my old negro man Anthony and my negro boy Randall together with all my house hold furniture my stock & my Wagon and train be left in the possession of my wife during her life but should she in the course of providence alter her way of living and get married, then the deforant legacies to be given up except my negro man Randall and Anthony, It is also my will and desire that my Executors hereafter to be named make such provision for my son Benjamin as they may think best, I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Temperance and my trusty friends Saml Blair and James Young my Executors to carry this my will into effect, having thus disposed of my temporal concerns I commend my spirit into the hands
