of my estate, by this my will to be divided just half
as much as his Brothers and sisters hereafter named
shall respectively have - My will is that my son
William R. Ashby my Daughter Jally Ashby my
Daughter Peggy Ashby my son John G. Ashby my
Daughter Nancy Ashby my Daughter Jane Ashby my
son Nathaniel Ashby and my son Haman Ashby
shall respectively be equal shares of my estate
except in the following case (which to me appears
just & reasonable to do) Whereas my above named
John G. Ashby and my Daughter Nancy Ashby
being the two youngest by my former wife and are
yet in a state of imperfect Childhood. My will and
desire is that the rents and profits of the remaining
half of the tract of land whereon I live shall
equally be for their benefit until my said son
John G. Ashby shall arrive to the age of twenty one
and my will with respect to my three youngest
Children (namely) Jane Ashby, Nathaniel Ashby
and Haman Ashby - which I have had by my
present wife and are in a state of infancy is
that in case of the death of their Mother before
they are raised that the land bequeathed to my
wife during her natural life shall not be sold
or in any way divided until the youngest of
them shall come to the age of twenty one and the
rents and profits of said land shall be appropriated
to their benefit in the way of their raising and
schooling - I now proceed to insert a list of
my land which is as follows (to wit) 380 acres
where I now live for which I have deeds of
Conveyance also 116 acres on Cyprus Creek

1166 acres on Elk creek - 3797 acres on Elk
Creek - 1580 acres on Muddy River - 600
acres on Muddy Creek - 400 acres on the east
or blue creek fork of Pond River all of which
are Military Lands on the south side of Green
River for which I also have deeds of Conveyance
also 400 acres in Hampshire County State of Virginia
which ^{deed} is in the Office of said County - 486 acres
on the Ohio River about 5 miles below the mouth
of Scioto as documents in the Registers office at
Frankfort will show 150 acres in the State of Ohio
deeds in the Office of Clarke County Kentucky
also a little Pond in Partnership with John Blackmon
for 2000 acres on Round Creek on the North side
of Green River - Original Patent from the State
of Virginia in my possession, also six or seven
head rights of 400 acres each on the South of
Green River all of which my will and desire is
shall by my Executors as soon as the nature of
things will admit, be divided into equal shares
with due regard to quantity and quality so that
each Child shall have as near as possible be of
equal value and divided amongst my nine last
mentioned Children by impartial lot except in the
case of my aforesaid son Moses Ashby who in this
is also to have just half as much as his
above mentioned ^{sister} Brothers & Sisters shall respectively
have and my will further is that each of the
legates shall possess and enjoy the benefit of
their estate so soon as they are married or arrive
at the above age of twenty one, I also by this my
last will and testament appoint and ordain
my two aforesaid sons (namely) Moses Ashby and
William R. Ashby Executors of this my will
