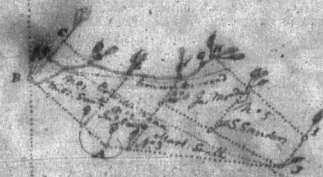

We the commissioners appointed by the Court of Jagelle to divide the tract of land lying in S^d County on the waters of North Elkhorn being the property of James Smith, do hereby agreeably to order laid of the same with as much accuracy as possible in to 5th lots, paying respect to quantity quality &c. of which the following is a specimen.

Survey for the heirs of J. Smith ac^d 132¹/₂ acres (being part of Phelps Military Survey; Beginning at a stake corner to James Smiths and adjacent Smiths lands, and running thence

N 45° W. 100 poles along S^d Smiths line to a buckeye and hickory in Joseph Rogers's line; thence

N 45° E 52 poles along S^d Rogers line to a buckeye corner to Joseph Rogers & thence
 S 50° E 30 poles along said Rogers line to 2 sugar trees on the bank of a small creek thence up the main p^r of
 S 71° E 44 poles, S 84° E 52 poles, S 65° E 28 poles,
 N 45° E 12 poles to a locust on one side of S^d creek and a buckeye on the other side in Bay Travers line thence
 S 47° E 140 poles along S^d Travers line to a sugar tree and ash stump in Nichols's line thence
 S 43° W 43 poles to a sugar tree and walnut, thence
 N 76¹/₂ W 185 poles to the Beginning.



N^o 1. being Samuel Smiths lot containing 27¹/₂ acres Beginning at S^d buckeye & hickory corner to Davis Smiths in Joseph Rogers's line and running thence S 45° E 73 poles along said S^d Smiths line, to a locust thence N 44° E 72¹/₂ poles to a hickory and sugar tree corner to J. Rogers & thence with S^d Joseph Rogers N 71° W 40 poles to two sugar trees another corner of S^d Rogers thence S 50° W 30 poles to a buckeye and the corner of S^d Rogers thence S 45° W 52 poles along a line of S^d Rogers land to the Beginning.
