In the name of God Amen I James Bullcock of the County of Fayette  
and State of Kentucky being of sound mind and Memory do this 18<sup>th</sup>  
day of May in the Year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Thirteen  
make and publish this my Last Will and Testament in & to the following  
To wit: I give devise and bequeath unto my Son Thomas Two hundred  
and fifty acres of land lying in the County of Woodford and on which  
he now lives, I also give bequeath and bequeath unto my Son Thomas  
one negro Man named Dick together with all the profits and  
Emoluments arising from said property since it came to his possession,  
I give devise and bequeath unto my Son Wm. Wm. Two Hundred &  
fifty acres of Land lying and Situate in the County of Woodford,  
State of Kentucky, and I give bequeath and bequeath unto my Son  
Wm. Wm. one Negro Man named Charles, with all the profits  
and emoluments arising from said property since it came into his possession.  
I give devise and bequeath unto my Son Wm. Wm. one Negro Man named Dick  
together with the profits Emoluments and advantages arising from his labor  
and service since he came to his possession, I give devise and  
bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Wilson one Negro Woman named

Martha, and her Child Minnie with all their increase since they  
were reduced to possession together with one feather Bed, one furniture  
and one Horse and Saddle, I give devise and bequeath unto my  
Daughter Barbara Wilson one Negro Woman named Phillis and Child with all  
their increase from the time at which they acquired possession, I give devise  
and bequeath unto my Daughter Agnes Bullcock one Negro Man named  
Rachel with all her increase, I give devise and bequeath unto my  
Daughter Anne Reed, one Negro Woman named Betsy with her Child  
and all their increase, All the above property having been given to and  
with the possession of the before named Legatees for a number of Years,  
the said Legatees are only intended as trustees and confirmation of the  
absolute Rights formerly retained to be vested, I give devise and bequeath  
unto my Daughter Martha S. Bullcock, one Negro Man named Frank  
as also one feather Bed, her Horse and Saddle, I give  
unto my beloved wife Anne Bullcock the tract of land whereon  
now live during her natural life after the termination of which  
I devise the same to my Son Wm. Wm. to him and his heirs for ever,  
I give devise unto my beloved wife Anne Bullcock the remainder  
of my Estate both real and personal during her natural life when  
this my Will shall be disposed of in the following manner  
to wit: So much shall be sold or will produce as Hundred pounds  
of which is to be equally divided between my Son in law Robert  
Bullcock and said Anne, in consequence of the Deficiency arising from the  
Distribution of my Negroes amongst my Children the sum of thirty pounds  
should it be necessary to raise so much, my Son Wm. Wm. is desired to  
appropriate in equal portions to the Support of four aged Negroes by name  
Thomas Peter Lane and Judy, or to appropriate fifteen pounds a piece  
for so many as shall remain alive when this part of my Last Will  
and Testament goes into effect, I give excepting the above named aged  
Negroes and the tract of Land, Devise to my Son Wm. Wm. it is my
