In the Name of our ever merciful Father & our Heavenly Father the Lord God Almighty the County of Fayette in the State of Kentucky being seated in Body but of perfect mind and memory blessed be the Almighty God for the same do publish this my last will & Testament in manner and form following

Item 1<sup>st</sup> It is my Desire that the plantation I now live on that my wife & I and enjoy the same together with the House & Negroes and other things Hereafter named I and my beloved wife Susanna Clark Lett Job and Puffny and her House hold and Cupboard Furniture & so much of her kitchen furniture as she may think proper to keep for the raising of her Family I do give to her six Hoes four work horses her choice of them & two young mares known by the names of the Names of The Republican Tilly & Demand Tilly I also give to her all my stock of Hogs and twelve head of sheep chosen of them & together with all my fowls of every kind and also give to her ten head of Cattle her choice of my stock together with all my farming utensils which I give to her during her Natural life or her widowhood.

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I give to my son John Clark four Hundred and fifty Dollars in addition to what I have heretofore given him.

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give to my Daughter Lucy five Hundred Dollars when she marries. Item 4<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Edmund Clark four hundred and fifty Dollars in addition to what I have already given him. Item 5<sup>th</sup> I give to my son Wm Clark four hundred and Sixty Dollars and one horse which he now has in possession. Item 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Drishy five Hundred Dollars when she marries. Item 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son James Clark when he shall arrive to the age of twenty years five Hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item 8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Mphers Clark five Hundred Dollars when he shall arrive to the age of twenty years five Hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item 9<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Clark when he shall arrive to the age of twenty years five hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item 10<sup>th</sup> I give to my son Peter Clark when he shall arrive to the age of twenty years five Hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item 11<sup>th</sup> I give to my son Samuel Clark when he shall arrive to the age of twenty years Five hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item 12<sup>th</sup> I give to my son Henry Clark when he shall arrive to the age of twenty years five hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item 13<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betsy Clark when she shall arrive to the age of Eighteen or Marries five Hundred Dollars to her and her heirs forever. Item 14<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Pockey Clark when she shall arrive to the age of Eighteen years or Marries five hundred Dollars to her and her heirs forever. Item 15<sup>th</sup> and further it is my will that if any of my sons shall marry before they come to age I <sup>direct</sup> my Executors hereafter named to pay to them their parts agreeable to my will. — Item 16<sup>th</sup> and further it is my will that all my sons when they shall arrive to the age of fifteen years shall be bound out to some good trade such as my Executors hereafter named shall think most to their advantage and further I direct that my son James Clark shall have six months schooling before he goes to <sup>France</sup> and my estate pay it. — Item 17<sup>th</sup> and further it is my Desire that all my sons before they are bound out to trade be Educated Equal to my first Sons and further I direct my Executors hereafter named if my wife shall die before all my children are schooled to have them schooled equal to my first children and my estate pay it before a final Division or reserve so much in their hands as will pay for schooling them. Item 18<sup>th</sup> and further it is my will and Desire that all my land lying in Lincoln and Warren Counties containing 500 <sup>acres</sup> be sold by my Executors at twelve months credit making all my right & title to a land Also my land on Green River 200 acres to be sold & sufficient Deed made by my Executors Hereafter named and further it is my Desire that all the property I have not Divided be sold <sup>as soon</sup> as my Executors Qualify at twelve months credit and further it is my Desire when my wife shall die in <sup>France</sup>
