In the Name of God amen I Archilam Moon of the County of Fayette And State of Kentucky being very sick & weak in Body but of sound Mind & Memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same do constitute write make & Ordains this my last will & testament writing And disannulling all others of what Nature or kind soever in Manner & form as followeth (to wit) Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Betsy Ann Moon twenty Shillings Current Money to herther heirs former to be paid by my Executors hereafter named Out of my Estate after my Wifes death Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my son Josiah Pleasant Moon twenty Shillings Current Money to be paid as above mentioned to him & his heirs forever Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly Norton Moon twenty Shillings Current Money to be paid as above described to her & her heirs forever Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly Venable Moon twenty Shillings Current Money to be paid as aforesaid to her & her heirs forever Item 5th It is also my desire that ~~the~~ the land is saved that Green Clay located for myself & Col^l William Henderson of Connelo County Virginia supposed to be on the waters of Nickman that whatever is saved be equally divided among my two sons Josiah Pleasant Moon & John Anderson Moon to them & their heirs forever
