

Heirs present Mr Bell Benj Berry John Berry and John Bell all of whom consented to the making and dividing the above survey as follows to wit: Beginning at A a Buckeye and dead sea Locust near the corner of Mr Bells meadow running thence N 71 1/2 W 225 1/2 poles to B a hickory and Honey locust thence S 15 E 153 poles to C a Hickory and white oak S 70 E 179 poles to an ash and dead Elm at D thence South 5 1/2 E 139 3/4 poles to a stake A 116 1/2 W 119 poles to the beginning
