But in case my wife should survive the whole of them and they should die without issue, it is my will that she shall enjoy the whole of my estate during her life and disposed of the third as she pleases Fourthly it is my will that so much of my stocks of Horses &c as will pay my just debts be disposed of by my Executors at their discretions and the residuum to be given to my wife under similar restrictions as the other part of my property which I have given her above, fifthly it is my will that in case all my Children by my present wife die infants & without issue that my Ex^{rs} pay out of my Estate to Charlotte Bowles one hundred & twenty Dollars & at the decease of my wife two thirds of my estate after deducting the one hundred & twenty Dollars be divided between my full Brothers Sisters & viz. Solomon Peter and Elizabeth Dawson or their Representatives & the Eliza Carter son of Solomons is to have a double portion that is as much again as either of his Brothers and sisters lastly I do hereby appoint my wife & William N. Land Guardians to my Children & do hereby nominate & appoint my wife, Nabbas Taylor Senr Henry Pans and William N. Land my Executors to this my last will & Testament in Testimony Whereof I do hereby set my hand & affix my Seal & acknowledged

the same as such this 27th July 1808

 sealed who is requested to receive the same with
 Contents as My last Gift. Thirdly it is My will
 that My Estate (except my stocks of all kinds My
 house hold & Kitchen furniture with My farming
 Utensils & Crops On hand & Now growing) be
 Equally divided Between My Wife Sarah Newton
 Her two Children & in Case she may be pregnant
 at this time (for such Child if Born alive) to have
 An equal Part with My Wife Sarah Newton
 Her two Children Isaac Newton & Polly Fairfax
 and in Case she is not pregnant, ~~with the~~ for My
 whole Estate, with the exceptions already Mentioned to be
 divided Between My Wife Sarah Newton & Isaac
 Newton Polly Fairfax (and the stocks of all kinds
 House hold & Kitchen furniture with the Crops
 to My Wife Sarah Newton) and in Case either
 of My Children should die & infant without issue
 the Portion Given to that One shall revert back
 & descend to the Other Or Others as May be. But I
 wish it understood that the Portion above
 Given to My wife is Only to be Considered as a
 life estate & after her death to be equally divided
 Between My two Children Isaac Newton & Polly
