 Thaddeus Dooling being the expense of keeping the orphan children of
 David Gillespie decd and some debts settled in said order the one third of
 500 lbs the 2^d Patsy Parish paid the other two thirds of said debts

 Patsy Gillespie her dower in the Estate of her husband David
 Gillespie decd agreeable to the above order upon the negroes being
 some few pounds short of her dower and the purchase property being
 1/3 more than her dower but the said Patsy Parish who married the widow
 is satisfied and we also allot to the said Patsy Parish the one
 third of the tract of land on Doon Creek containing one hundred
 and twenty acres which is forty acres - And the said Patsy Parish
 is to pay 1/3rd of all debts that shall come against the said
 Estate and the expenses of the children in the year 1803 and 2^d the
 debts which is contained in a settlement made with Thaddeus Dooling
 the amt of which is due the said Patsy Gillespie Given under
 our hands this 4th day of January 1804
