Let the Campers of Fayette County and State of Kentucky being of Sound mind and disposing memory Do make Ordain and appoint this my Last Will and Testament. I do hereby declare that after my decease all my Just debts be paid - after which that my Temporary Estate be disposed off as follows -

Item I give and bequeath to my Son John Camper one negro boy named Sanders and one negro Girl named Eliza to him and his heirs for ever -

Item I give to my Son William Camper one negro Girl named Nancy and one negro Boy named Moses to him and his heirs for ever -

Item I give and bequeath to my Son John Camper one negro Woman named Sarah and her Son to him and his heirs for ever -

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Henry Camper one negro Man named Dens and the said little and a cow and calf to him and his heirs for ever -

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy & Martin one negro Boy named Lewis and one negro Girl named Eliza to her and her heirs for ever -

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Lettice Leons one negro Girl named Selah and Mary to her during her life and after her death to her for Children to them and their heirs for ever -

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Alice Roach one negro Woman named Sarah and her Youngest Child to her and her heirs for ever -

Lastly I do make and appoint my Son Robin Camper and Henry Camper my sole and sole Executors to this my Last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 10th day of March one thousand eight hundred and Twelve
