Wm the commissioners appointed by the Court of Jayette to divide the tract of land lying in S^d County on the waters of North Elkhorn being the property of James Smith, do hereby agreeably to order laid of the same with as much accuracy as possible in the S^d date, paying respect to quantity quality &c. of which the following is a specimen.

Survey for the heirs of J. Smith ac^o 132 1/2 acres (being part of Phelps Military Survey; Beginning at a stake corner to James Smith and adjacent Smith's land, and running thence N 45° W 108 poles along S^d Smith's line to a buckeye and buckeye in Joseph Rogers's line, thence
