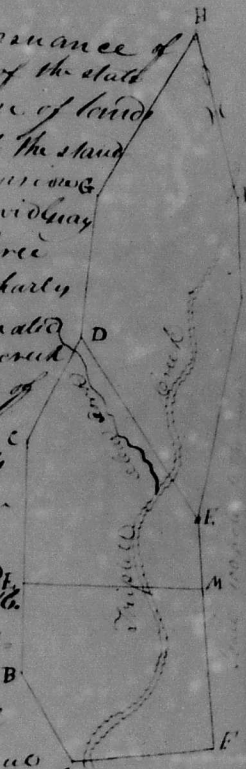


A court held for Fleming County on the 4th day of August
This allotment of acres to the widows & division
of land between the heirs of Emanuel Kelly

Fleming County &c. In pursuance of
the several acts of assembly of the state
of Kentucky for the division of land
we the undersubscribers, two of the standing
commissioners of said division of
land at the request of David Gray
of Fleming County to divide three
tracts of land patented to Charles
Harrison and said Gray situated
in Fleming County on English creek
part of an entry in the name of
Emanuel Kelly of 2270 acres
made the first of March 1784
we have made the division in
pursuance of an agreement
submitted by said Gray entering
into on the 26th of December 1786
and in consideration of two assign-
ments of the said Charles
Harrison & David Gray one of
said assignments made to Emanuel
Harrison of two hundred acres and the other
to Joseph McElhiney for three hundred acres. Said
assignments bears date the 6th of November 1786
And said assignments being the consideration which
Harrison & McElhiney notes (that is mentioned in said
Harrison & Grays aforesaid Agreement) was given
And we have assigned to said Gray the one
equal half of Emanuel Kelly's first survey
the aforesaid entry containing 476 1/4 acres



and represented in the annexed plate (505)
by the letters A, B, C, D, E, F. that part of said
survey that we assigned to David Gray is
bounded as follows: Beginning at A two
sugar trees & 2 yew more on the bank
of the creek the beginning corner of said 476 1/4
acres thence with the line thereof North 31°
West 120 poles to B 2 pines & white oak corner
to said 476 1/4 acres thence with another line
thereof N 17° E 104 1/2 poles to C a stake thence
S 72 3/4° E 211 poles to D a stake in a line of said
476 1/4 acres thence with the same S 12 3/4° W
190 7/8 poles to E two black oaks and hickory
corner to Harrison and Grays said 476 1/4 acres
Thence with another of the lines thereof
N 51° W 166 poles to the beginning containing
two hundred thirty eight & one eighth acres.
And in pursuance of the aforesaid agreement
of Harrison & Grays we assign to said Gray the
whole of the second survey of Emanuel Kelly
on the aforesaid entry which contains 494 acres
and is represented on the foregoing plate by the
letters D, G, H, I, K, E, and bounded as follows:
beginning at D the most northwestwardly cor-
ner of said Kelly's first survey on the above
entry a white oak, dogwood and gum thence
N 22 1/2° E 168 poles to G a black oak and poplar
thence N 47° E 372 poles to H a Red oak and hick-
ory in the west boundary of a survey made for William
Lins. Thence south with said line 200
poles to I three white oaks. Thence S 10 W 117 poles

To K two maples & white oak near a small brook
thence S 32 1/2° W 323 poles to E three white oaks thence
N 15° W 256 poles to the beginning
And in pursuance of Harrison & Grays
foreclosed agreement we assign to said
David Gray that part of David and
Joseph Thomas and Joseph McColung
lands that lies within Emanuel Kellys
third and fourth surveys of the aforesaid
said entry, said Harrison & McColung
lands in Kellys said surveys
contains four hundred and
forty eight and one fourth acres
23 poles and one half of the
Callance of Kellys said survey
which is 298 acres & 1/2 poles
Kellys said third survey
contained 785 1/2 acres and
his fourth 259 acres & that
part of said survey that
we assign to said Gray is
bounded as follows beginning
at two white oaks
