Daughter Elizabeth it is my will that the remainder of my
property be sold to the best advantage and that the my
Daughter Elizabeth have to her share so much money as
will be Equal to other of the Other Shares thereof money to
be put to use in the hands of some good man her giving
Security for the same which money she may draw at the
age of twenty And when she comes if she should chance to
marry it is also my will that all and every feast and
parties set And Lots of my estate be seen And Auction
take place appearance to some good honest respectable men
and that after my debt be paid as before mentioned that the
same be divided in four Equal Shares the One to my wife Elizabeth
her taking the property Above mentioned towards her Share One
Other share to my son Ephraim his taking the property above
mentioned towards his share which property and money shall
be safely kept by my Executors which I shall hereafter
mention also One Other part to my son James his taking
towards his share the property Above mentioned which prop-
