

In the Name of God Amen I Geo. McDonald of the County of Shuning, being sick and weak in body, but of sound mind and memory for which I thank God, and calling to mind the uncertainty of Human life, and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as I have pleased God to bless me with. I give and bequeath in the following manner that is to say,

1st I desire that all my just debts be paid by my son William. & Geo. McDonald also pay to Mary McDonald my wife six hundred Dollars, when called for after four years if she should live before that period the same to her at her disposal.

2nd I give to William Whaler my son-in-law the sum of one Dollar.

3rd I give to my Daughter Jane McDonald the sum of One Dollar.

4th I give to my son-in-law John Dougherty the sum of or Margaret his wife my Daughter one Dollar.

5th I give my son Peter G. McDonald one note for \$44.58 cents in Lawrence G. Gowen.

6th I give my son John McDonald the sum of one dollar.

7th I give my daughter Elizabeth Schmael the sum of one Dollar.

8th I give my son Thomas McDonald the sum of one Dollar.

9th I give my daughter Anne Cull, the sum of one Dollar.

10th I give my son William McDonald the sum of one Dollar and all the remainder of my lands & Possessions of every kind what soever they be out of which he is to make the aforesaid payments with the reserve that he is to convey the right to Thomas Schmael to the tract of land that said

Thmael now lives on containing fifty acres by his paying the sum of ninety Dollars against the 1st day of March 1820. And also make the right to John Cull the place on which he hold no possession containing fifty acres by his paying the sum of ninety Dollars to be paid against the 1st day of March 1820. he it known that the said William McDonald is to have the fifty acres above the miter that he has paid for the balance as aforesaid and as follows 11th I give to my son James McDonald the sum of one Dollar and the land that he has got and traded to Tinsley for which he is to pay one hundred dollars against the first day of March 1820. Be it clearly understood that the miter-living is Thomas Schmael pays ninety dollars and John Cull ninety Dollars and James McDonald one hundred Dollars the aforesaid Reversion is for the several children to have and to hold forever. And the right that said William McDonald is to make to said Schmael and Cull is to be a quit claim deed.

12th I constitute and appoint my son William McDonald executor of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all others & former wills or testaments by me heretofore made, 13th and lastly ~~of~~ my soul I recommend to the Lord my body to the ground. Amen, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 28th day of May 1819.

In pursuance of an order of the Honorable the County Court of Henning granting a division of Patrick Channow's county land, Me the undersigned met upon said decedent's land, on the 9th of April 1819 which consists of five sub lots in the Town of Henningburg. Distinguished on the plat of said Town by Lots Nos. 7, 8, 9 & 10 also and tract conveyed by George Stockton to said Channow said to contain four & three fourth acre, 37 poles, also one other tract said to contain twenty acre, conveyed by Archibald Stockton to said Channow and having run around the aforesaid land, and ascertained that they contain 54 acre, & 28 poles, and then divided it into 14 lots, allotting each heir to have a lot of the improved and condemned land and a lot of timber land of which the annexed plat and following notes will further explain.

Lot No. 1 part of the condemned & improving land containing three acre, & fifty two poles, & bounded as follows: Beginning at A a stake on the south bank of Stockton's branch running through Henningburg said stake being the North East corner to Lot No. 10 and in the west boundary of Main cross street through said Town thence with said street south 33° W. sixty three poles to B a stake thence

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and 92th poles to figure 1 a stake thence N 93° E 68 poles to 2 a stone in the aforesaid branch in the south boundary of the common around the inlet of said Town thence with the common S 56° E 150 poles to the Beginning Lot No. 2 part of condemned and improving land containing four & one half acre, 29 poles, and bounded as follows: Beginning at figure 1 corner to Lot No. 1 thence with the same S 33° E 68 poles to 3 a stone in the south boundary of common fencing thence with the common North 56° W 104 poles to 4 a stone thence South 33° W 75 poles to 5 a stake thence East 15 poles to the Beginning

Lot No. 3 part of condemned and improving land containing four acre one half & thirty three poles, and bounded as follows: Beginning at figure 4 a stake thence North 11° 56' E 33 poles to 6 a stake thence S 33° E 83 poles to 6 a stake in East boundary of common thence with the same S 56° E 92 poles to 8 a stone thence S 33° W 75 poles to the Beginning Lot No. 4 containing 3 acre & 21 poles, including the dwelling house and part of the orchard, occupied by Daniel Brown & bounded as follows: Beginning at 6 a stake thence with the common S 56° W 15 poles to 7 a stone thence S 33° W 32 poles to 8 a stake thence S 56° E 15 poles to 9 a stake thence S 33° E 33 poles to the Beginning

Lot No. 5 containing four acre and seventy three poles, including the spring and part of the orchard & bounded as follows: Beginning at figure 7 a stake thence with S 14° E 33 W 32 poles to 8 a stake thence S 56° E 15 poles to 9 a stake thence S 33° W 11 poles to 10 a stake thence North 56° W 20 poles to 11 a stake thence S 14° W 25 poles to 12 a stake in the east boundary of Blue lick road thence with the
