 form following To wit I give unto my Son Noah 157 acres
 of Land which I give the one half because he is my son the other
 half by paying 100 dollars paying interest from this date which
 money I want appropriated to the use of schooling my little
 children V. D. I give the whole residue on Chris to Noah Wright
 but if the land is lost no recourse on my heirs my other lands

to be divided equal quantity and quality improved and unimproved Between Asa and Noble both alike which to be kept in their Mothers hands untill her death and every thing else of property kind, Asa to get twenty four shillings dollars worth of property the rest from oldest to youngest of the girls to be made up as much and at their mothers death all the Household furniture and Stock to be equally divided Amongst them the farming utensils to be divided between Asa and Noble my wife has to make a deed to James Alexander according to the Bond that Vaughan gave not to come higher than twenty rods of the road to include all his old improvement the deed to be made at Alexanders cost entirely as I never recd anything for it she has to collect my moneys due and pay my debts out of it departed Aprile the fourth 1814

James Wrights last will and Testament made in the presence of Thomas Kincaid and Charles Harper

Personally appeared before me one of the Commissioners Justices of peace for Fleming County, Thomas Kincaid & Charles Harper both of full age and first duly sworn both the within will was wrote by the direction of the within James Wright about 24 or 30 hours before his death & that he was in his perfect senses & further he declared that it should be his Will in case he then died and Declared said Kincaid to put his name to the same after his death and that the will was signed by them before the death of the Testator as Witnesses & further sayeth not whenunto they have affixed their hands and seals this 7th Novr 1814

And give following viz Principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty god that gave it and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the almighty power of God And as touching such worldly estate with it hath pleased god to bless me in this life I give and dispose of the same in the following manner I give first I bequeath and give to my well beloved wife Nancy Seybold the third part of my estate after all debts are paid to be paid to her by my Executors as they see the stands in need thereof And the balance of my estate I will and bequeath to each of my children to be equally divided between them with the exceptions hereafter mentioned - It is to be understood that my daughter Rebecca is to keep the negro boy Elijah which is not to be considered part of the estate I also give and bequeath unto my son Jasper Seybold my Silver Watch and Silver Coat buttons which is not to be a part of his portion and I also give and bequeath to my daughter Malinda a set of Silver Spoons extra of his part of his part of the estate I also will and request that all my personal estate be sold and a sufficient quantity of money retained in the hands of my Executors to purchase my land again in case it should be lost in the suit now depending in the Fleming Circuit Court - I also will and request that my Executors take my two youngest daughters and furnish them with a commodious home where they have to well taken care of as I do not consider my wife capable of taking care of them being to his present known state of mind -

It is my wish that my Executors put my little boys to learn good trades I do hereby appoint my sons John Seybold and Dempsey Seybold my sole executors of this my last will and testament and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other former will legacies bequests and Execution by me in any way before named ratifying and confirming this to be my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written signed sealed & delivered in the presence
