Item I desire the following

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In the Name of GOD amen the twenty fourth day of December in the year of our Lord GOD of blessed memory I John Miles Senior of Blount County & State of Kentucky do begin being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to GOD for all his many good blessings & mercies bestowed upon me therefore calling me to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, I do make & declare this my last will & Testament, that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul to GOD who gave it and for my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian manner with decency at

the intention of my Executors not doubting at the general
resurrection that I shall receive the same again by the
mighty hand of GOD and as touching my worldly estate
whereunto it hath pleased GOD to use me in this life
I give & devise & dispose of in the following manner &
form, I give and bequeath to Elizabeth my dearly beloved
wife, one third of all my Estate during her life & at her
death to make an equal division of the same amongst
the children, also I do appoint Elizabeth my wife and
John Hunt Cogswell my whole and sole Executors to pay
or cause to be paid out of my real and personal estate, all
my just debts and lawful expenses of my funeral, then
afterwards to give every child as they come of age a full
share that shall be coming to them and I further bequeath
to my son John Price all my Land when I now live
and that he the said John Price jointly receiving the same
shall and is bound as follows to pay in three years after my
decease to my Daughter Mary and Kithen their full shares
there two parts from that which is given after my decease
he shall pay or cause to be paid to Elizabeth & Christina
their equal parts out of said estate, at the direction
of my Executors which I have before mentioned & do hereby
utterly avow all and every other will & Testament
and legal requests and bequests by me in any wise before
this time made written or bequeathed satisfying and
confirming this my last will & Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal the date as first mentioned

in the last will & Testament on the

I Joseph McKittrick of Fleming County and State of Kentucky do
make this my last Will & Testament in manner following to wit
First I give and bequeath to my wife Mary a negro girl slave
named Liza and one hundred Dollars in Cash and horses
or I have such a one as she shall chose and some other things and
furniture with furniture first all the pence that I may
have at my death two Cows such as she ^{may} make chose of
among my cattle and one half of all the rest of my house
hold furniture not before mentioned and my son in law
is to live with my son William this is to be for his own
his part of the Land my son William shall be oblig'd to
support her decently and my son William is to have the
remainder part of my house hold furniture and the
plantation that I am now living on is to be sold to pay all
debts and demands my son William is to have the place
where and gain that I now have I bequeath I give to Liza
McDonald that was my only Love one dollar - one hundred
Acres of Land lying in the now western territory joining the
now east end of Mitchell's claim I give & bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth L. Harvey the land is to be sold the money is to be
equally divided between the two & Mary's part put to interest.
I leave my Daughter Elizabeth twenty five Dollars more to be
paid when the land is sold that I am now living on I give and
bequeath to my Daughter Mary a good horse saddle & bridle &
give her her own furniture I give her twenty five Dollars more
to be paid when the land is sold that I am now living on my
daughter Harvey is to have one year schooling my Love that I
have in the now western territory is to be equally divided
into three parts my son Hugh is to have his when he reaches
at two dollars p^r acre Joseph is to have 1st place to have the
now live at two dollars p^r acre William is to have his in
Wood Lane It is to be laid off or convenient as possible to
be together, My to agree one horse is to be to the use of my three
sons the remainder part of my movable property I leave to my
son William after his mother's debts gets their part the remainder
part of my land that I am now living on is to be sold and the
money equally divided into three parts to my son Hugh &
Joseph & William after my just debts are paid some expenses of my
funeral are paid the remainder of my estate both real & personal
I give and bequeath to which the are to have them when
they grow. I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Mary
and son Hugh Joseph the only Executors & Executors to carry into
effect this my last will & Testament and hereby Vest in them
