in Fleming and State of Kentucky, being
Sick and weak of body but of sound &
disposing mind and memory that a proper
disposition of that Estate goods chattels rights and
credits shall and enjoy may be made. Do make
this my last will and Testament in manner
and form following (that is to say)

Impimus I do here desire that my Body
should receive a decent Burial at the
direction of my Executors hereinafter named
also I will and desire that my Just
debts and funeral expenses be paid as
speedily as possible out of a fund to be raised
for that purpose by a sale (upon a reasonable
credit at the direction of my Executors) of
the house and lot I now occupy which
my Executors are hereby Authorized to convey
to the purchaser. Also I hereby will and
bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Scott
Widow of Elliot of William Scott late of the

Town and County of same deceased One bedstead
further bed and bedding shetele belonging together
with a Stand of bed curtains One Bureau One
Breakfast Table and One wheel barrow to her, her heirs
and assigns forever - Also I desire and bequeath
to my beloved wife Rachel Price all my household
furniture on Solvations forth of nothing and all the
Residue of my personal property to have hold use
occupy and enjoy the same during her natural life
and after her decease that the same be Equally divided
between my son Nathan price my Daughter Elizabeth
Price and the children of my Deceased Daughter
Annash Scott to the wife of John S. Scott. It is
also my wish and desire that if the house and lot
aforesaid should not upon the sale thereof herein
directed produce a sufficient fund for the purpose
charged upon it that then and in that case such share
of my personal property as my Executors may think
proper shall be appropriated to that purpose (specific
legacies excepted) and whereas the house & lot aforesaid
was once the property of my son-in-law William
Scott deceased as aforesaid and the said Elizabeth
Scott not having Relinquished her right of Dower
therein upon the sale thereof to me It is my will
that if upon a sale thereof by my Executors as
herein Directed she should Relinquish will and do
legally Relinquish her Dower therein to the purchaser
that then and in that case I desire my Executors
to pay to the said Elizabeth her heirs or assigns
the value thereof Justly & Reasonably to be computed
by disinterested persons out of funds to be raised as
aforesaid. It is further my will and desire that if Joseph
Alexander should survive my wife Rachel Price that
immediately upon her decease or within a convenient
time thereafter he receive out of that part of my

This day I Thomas Finney of Fleming County and State of Kentucky being very weak and unable to get in my right mind and judgment about coming to execute the mortgage of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and declare this my last will and Testament that is to say I give and bequeath to Marjory my beloved wife the whole of my Estate real and personal during her life to be at her expense and for her issue while she lives and after her death the same to be divided equally among the well behaved only I am to have fifth parts more than any of the rest if any of my children behaves bad or drunkardly or lewd or behaves unbecomingly to Christians let them have not more than one dollar of my Estate apiece And the rest to be divided among the well behaved after her death This is given in her own right to give Andrew a horse and saddle for his use that he behave well I leave near Thomas near Marjory's house I leave all and the gains that she can I leave no right in the same then even I further will that she buy lands when and where she pleases as soon as my money can be got and to lay out the rest of the for improvement for their convenient living And I desire my son James to assist me in all the business and concerns of my Estate In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal the Eleventh day of February and thousand eight hundred and eighth
