I will and positively order that all my just debts be paid and funeral Expenses at my home then I hereby give and bequeath unto my Sons, Joseph and Joseph Blamer the sums of five Shillings each I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Leavelle Mary both John Harvey and Elizabeth the sum of five Shillings each and further more I hereby give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Blamer the income of all my estate real and personal to be under the direction of her government and directions during her life to have and to hold the same in peaceable possession without any Security and furthermore to hereby appoint her the said Mary sole executrix of this my last will and testament hereby Resolving all former wills by me made in Mass. whosoever I have written see my hand sealed this twentyfifth day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eleven.
