Term my county Kentucky July 8th 1818
In the name of God (James) Richard
Green being sworn in body but of sound
perfect memory do make
publish thus my last will & testament
in manner & form following that is to
say first I will that my personal
funeral expenses be paid out of the
first money raised of my estate
next that the doctors fees shall be
payed out of & afterwards all my just
lawful debt shall be payed & further I
will that the remainder of my estate
shall be disposed as follows to wit I

I direct that my Grand daughter
Catherine Reed shall have one fourth
part & all the furniture thereof for the time
I direct that my beloved wife Elizabeth shall
have the remainder of all my estate to use
as personal during her natural life that
she shall have the privilege of giving to either
of her daughters Elizabeth & Lucy Reed Lang
thing she shall think proper which she has
only not to exceed what will be their part
of my estate when divided & further I will
I direct that after my decease there shall
be a bondue made for much of my property
shall be sold as shall be necessary for pay
ing all my debts whatever my wife Elizabeth
shall not stand in need of I direct to be sold
as soon as possible I will I direct that after
the death of my wife the remainder of
my property shall be sold also that my
land shall be sold in the following manner
(to wit) to be sold to the highest bidder
by giving Bond & approved security to be
paid in three equal annual payments
after the sale thereof & further I will
I direct that after the decease of my wife
the money if collected that it shall be
equally divided among all my children
that the three children of my daughter
Caroline Reed Esq. shall have as much as
would have been their Mother's share if she
had lived & further I do will & appoint my
son Wm. Green Guardian for my two daughters

Elizabeth & Mary Dea & the children
 Caroline Dea & I do hereby will
