In the name of God Amen this 11th day of June 1814
I William Wilson of the County of Fleming and State of Kentucky
being sick and weak in body and of perfect mind and memory
thanks be to god thereof and calling to mind the Mortality of my
body and that it is appointed for all men out to die do make and
ordain this my last will and Testament that that is to say
praisably and first of all I give and recommend my soul into
the hands of Almighty god who gave it and recommend my body
to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial
at the discretion of my Executor nothing doubting doubting but
at the General resurrection I shall receive the again by the
mighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate
wherein it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give
and dispose of the same in the following manner and form
first I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy Wilson a
reasonable Maintenance of the Land that I now live on also
she is to draw from the notes that I hold on my Children
the following articles viz Cotton Flax leather & sand as she
may stand in need of these necessaries and also to keep portion
of the House that she now lives in let her have a comfortable
house built in the yard near the old dwelling house which I allow
of my sons to be an equal share towards building and fixing the
same which she are to have a discount out of the Notes which I
hold on them I also will and bequeath to my two Sons Samuel
and Alexander all that plantation that I now live on containing
one hundred and sixty acres to be equally divided between them
and also to my son Samuel the Still and all the Vessels belonging
thereto and to Alexander my Loom and all the tacklings be-
longing thereto And also my Corners Robert Robert and bottle
plow and plow gears I also will and bequeath to my daughter
Jean who is intermarried with Wm Carpenter my large
bottle all my hogs a Sea Gallon pot and pot Rack I also
will and bequeath to my daughter Anny who is intermarried
with James Bradshaw one bed and furniture one Grid
Iron and heifer Calve I also will and bequeath to my
daughter Sally who is intermarried with Robert Hughes my
chest of Drawers Cutting Box and Knife also will & bequeath
to my son William all my land that I hold on which water

to go to his two Sons Harvey and William I also will and
bequeath to my son Thomas and my son John my Wagon

 which I hold on my children and I also as to my

 paying my just debts and Surging charges and be it
 rightly understood that whatever remains of the notes which
 I hold on my children not paid at her death I also as
 bequeath for the schooling my grand children and so
 hereby disallow Breake and disannul all and every former
 wills and legacies and executions by me anywise before made
 sold and bequeathed ~~offering~~ and confirming this and
 No other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand seal this 4th day of June 1844
