sister Nancy J. Hartwell & William P. Morgan
my Brother to be equally divided among them

in the following manner Nancy who have my
share of the plantation being about three hundred
acres when my mother was alive the value is to be placed
on it by my brother Daniel & Morgan & William P.
Fleming then my brother William is to have an equal
share ~~from~~ and the residuum if any is to equally divided
lastly I appoint Mr P. Fleming and Daniel Morgan
Executors of this my last will & testament revoking
all others In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal the 23rd March 1826
