At a Court held for Fleming County on the 5th day of April 1824 The bill of sale of the Estate of Joseph Corlin decd. was produced in Court, examined and ordered to be recorded which is done Teste Joshua Lockman Clerk

In the name of God, Amen I Margaret Duncan of Fleming County and State of Kentucky being weak and afflicted in body though sound in mind do declare this instrument of writing to be my last will and testament revoking all others, whatever and it is my express wish that the following legacies be paid to the respective legates as soon after my decease as possible And first I bequeath unto my beloved daughter Margaret Reily of Allegany County Pennsylvania the sum of two hundred specie dollars likewise the interest of the sum of five hundred dollars annually of the proceeds of the farm whereon she now resides for the term of her natural life and at her decease the amount in full if she outlive her go for the interest & benefit of Elizabeth Finley (wife of David O. Finley) & Sarah Libson if not it shall be for the use and benefit of their respective heirs, I likewise leave to my Grandson David Clarke two hundred dollars and my Grand Daughter Hannah Rheames two hundred dollars and to her Daughter Margaret Logan one hundred dollars, and to Mary Campbell two hundred dollars I likewise bequeath unto Sarah Libson every species of furniture beds bedding &c. that I possess at my death, I leave unto David O. Finley my Grandson three hundred dollars specie to his daughter

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Daughter Margaret I leave one hundred
dollars, to his Daughter Martha one hundred
dollars, and to my Daughter Hannah
Finley and Son Samuel Duncan I leave to
each one dollar they having already received
a larger portion than any of the legates
above named I also leave to my granddaughter
Sarah Gibson, the amount due me on two
bonds executed to me by Triplett & Early toward
one for seven hundred dollars, and one for two
hundred with the Interest now accrued & that
may hereafter accrue until paid, I also leave
to Abraham Clarke one hundred dollars & to
Margaret Chibbey I leave two hundred dollars
all ^{my} papers relative to my Town property
in Saint Louis State of Missouri It is my
will that they be placed in the hands of
David R. Finley to make what use of them
his discretion may direct In witness of the
above being my last Will and testament I
do appoint my Friends James Young Esq. and
George Stewart Esq. of Pittsburgh, Alleghany and
Pennsylvania and William P. Fleming of Fleming
County Kentucky Executors, to see the same
duly fulfilled & executed - Witness my hand &
seal this fifth day of April in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty
four.
