 Stockton being weak of body but of sound mind &
 mind memory do make known & establish this
 at my last will & Testament. First it is my
 desire that my body be buried in a
 Christian like manner at the discretion of
 my Exors heirs or mentioned lastly
 what property it hath pleased God to
 bestow upon me I wish disposed of
 in the following manner viz to Amanda
 Norwood I will bequeath the sum of one
 hundred dollars to Nancy Norwood the like
 sum of one hundred dollars likewise one
 Bureau bed & bedstead & clothing being the same
 I now have. To Eliza Norwood I give the
 like sum of one hundred dollars these are my
 Grand children & daughters of my son James
 To James Hood I will bequeath one negro boy
 slave named Abraham to him his heirs & assigns
 forever. To Rosanna Hood my Granddaughter
 I will bequeath one negro slave named Harriet
 to her her heirs and assigns forever. To Betsey
 Hood my Daughter I will bequeath the services
 of my negro woman Rebecca until she arrives
 at the age of thirty five years when it is
 my will & desire that said Beck shall be
 freed but if the said Beck shall in the mean
 time have any children they are to be the
 property of my said Daughter to have to her
 her heirs and assigns forever

I also will and bequeath to my said daughter
 Betsey Hood one negro girl named Martha (born)
 to have and to hold the same to her her heirs
 and assigns And I will bequeath the balance
 of my estate of whatsoever nature to my said
 Daughter Betsey Hood to have and to hold the
 same to her her heirs and assigns the legacies
 heretofore willed in money to my grand daughters
 are to be paid to them as soon as the same may
 be collected out of the debt due me lastly
 I do hereby constitute and appoint my son in law
 James Hood my sole Exor of this my last will
 & Testament revoking all others by me made
 in testimony whereof I have to these presents set
 my hand and affixed my seal the third day
 of August 1826.
