 God willing to mind the mortality of my Body
 and knowing that it is appointed for all men
 once to die do make and ordain this my
 last will and Testament, that is to say Primarily
 and first of all I give and recommend my soul
 unto Almighty God that give it and my Body to
 Earth to be buried in a decent manner and as touching
 my worldly Estate which I have pleased God
 to bless me with I give and dispose of in the
 following manner to wit: first I give the gift
 to Mary Ballentine my loving wife all my Estate
 viz: all my moveable property such as cattle horses
 & kitchen furniture and beds she doring with all
 debts due & becoming due and with all the claim
 I have for six acres of ground in William Graham
 to her in peaceable possession to dispose of as she
 thinks proper with the exception of her having to each
 of my three son-in-laws that is to say William
 Graham and Robert Aaron & Philip Hawk
 which I bequeath to them out of my worldly

estate one dollar each. Given under my
 hand and seal this fifth day of January 1820

 the value of forty five dollars. I will & bequeath unto my
 Daughter Nancy twenty five dollars a year as long as she
 remains unmarried to be paid by my wife Jane & at the
 death of my wife Jane all the personal Estate to be
 equally divided between my children Elizabeth, William,
 John, Alexander, & Adam Jane Elizabeth, Theophilus,
 Randie & Nancy. I appoint my wife Jane Executrix
 of this my last will and Testament
 signed sealed & acknowledged this 10th day of
 December 1822 in the presence of
 John Harmon, Benjamin Braxton
