In the name of God Amen I Samuel Henry of Fleming County State of Kentucky being of full age and knowing that it is the lot of all men once to die & being in a low state of health but of sound mind & memory and being desirous to settle my business as to distribute that portion of this world's goods which God has blessed on me I do hereby constitute this my last will & testament in the following words: That is to say I will & bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth Henry the use of all my real & personal property during her natural life after her death it is my will that the property above mentioned shall be sold on such credit as the Executors ^{shall} think best and pay to my son Thomas Henry fifty dollars to my ^{son} Samuel Henry fifty dollars to my Daughter Maryann Duncan fifty dollars to my daughter Sally Koca fifty dollars and to my daughter Nancy Dent fifty dollars the the balance of money arising on the sale of the aforesaid property to be equally divided among my children by the above mentioned Elizabeth Henry namely: I do name my Henry James Henry Isaac Milmon Elizabeth Henry Margaret Henry William M Henry Robert P Henry Matilda

Henry but should my wife Elizabeth Henry after my death marry it is my will that all my real & personal property shall then be sold as the executor of this my last will & testament shall deem best & the money ^{arising} therefrom
