of Kentucky Knowing that it is appointed
of me for all men to die and being in full
body but of perfect mind & memory do appoint
establish and ordain this to be my last will
and testament in manner & form as follows

First I do allow my body to receive a decent
and Christian burial Secondly I do allow all my
lawful and just debts to be paid Item I do
will and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Ferguson
my boy Mary and her side saddle Item it is my
will and desire that all the balance of my
Estate both real and personal shall be divided into
three equal parts or shares one of said parts or
shares I do will and bequeath to my beloved wife
Mary Ferguson and one other part or share I do
