Item 1st It is my will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expences be speedily and punctually paid

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Stickrod all my estate both real and personal (after deducting the legacies here after named) for and during the time of her widow hood or natural life but in the event of her marriage it is my will that she retain one third of what

may then remain on hand of my estate and the other two thirds be equally divided between all my children

Item 3^d I give of my estate to my son Henry Pickrod the sum of one dollar and fifty cents and to my daughter Elizabeth Pickrod the same amount also to my two daughters Charlotte & Maryann Pickrod the sum of one dollar & fifty cents each and to my three sons Jacob William & Joseph Pickrod the sum of one dollar and fifty cents each

Item 4th It is my will and desire and I hereby appoint my true and faithful friend William McEwell Sen: Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of Sept. 1832 Signed sealed and published Jacob Pickrod (Seal) in presence of
